## **2010/2011 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The Board of Directors of the ISA Pipeline Subsection has approved a scholarship program to be awarded for the 2010/2011 school year. Please inform and encourage everyone who is eligible to participate. The requirements are as follows:

- Scholarships are awarded to successful applicants who attend an accredited school, college or university in the Fall 2010 and Spring 2011 semesters as a full time student pursuing a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester in an undergraduate program.
- Applicant must be nominated by someone who has attended a minimum of four (4) ISA Pipeline Subsection monthly luncheon meetings and/or activities beginning August 1, 2009 through April 30, 2010, excluding the May meeting. The nominator must confirm that he or she is confirmed as attending and is listed on the Meeting Attendance Sheet at each meeting/function for that meeting to count. The nominator can only nominate one student per fiscal year.
- The applicant must compose and submit an essay of no less than 500 words describing their future goals and the contribution that a scholarship would have in achieving those goals. *NOTE: The selection criteria for awarding scholarships and honor scholarships will be based on an essay ranking system. (An honor scholarship combines a normal scholarship and a donation from our Corporate Direct Sponsors of Scholarships.)*
- The applicant must be a High School Senior or a college student.
- The applicant must not be the recipient of any other ISA Houston Section scholarships in the current or the previous fiscal year. The ISA Pipeline Subsection scholarship will not be awarded to the same person in consecutive years.
- The applicant must submit a copy of their recent school transcript.
- The applicant, immediate family member, and/or nominating party must attend the May 19, 2010 meeting of the ISA Pipeline Subsection at the Houston Engineering and Scientific Society (HESS) facilities.
- All scholarships will be submitted directly to the college or university at which the scholarship recipient is enrolled to pay for normal tuition, enrollment fees and textbooks for the specified school year. The scholarship will be made payable to the educational institution the student is attending.

Notes to applicants: To be considered, the application (separate student & nominator forms are accepted) and associated documents must be postmarked no later than March 31, 2010. **Any application postmarked after March 31, 2010 will be not considered.** If there are any questions, contact Craig Chaszar - Siemens at 281-856-4406 or any Board of Director listed in the newsletter.
